- Sunday, August 14, 6:00 PM - Please plan to attend "A Musical Tapestry" of vocal and instrumental music (from Gospel to Classics), led by musicians from our congregation and the community. Stay tuned for more details!
- Safe Church - The Council approved a Safe Church policy for our congregation. It aims to: (1) Promote a safe environment that is free of abuse for children, youth, as well as adults, and (2) To help identify and appropriately address suspected abuse. Additional information will be forthcoming.
- Facilities Update - The Building Team is working on design and location options for the cadet/utility building as well as play equipment. Also, the sale of two two-acre parcels of land is being pursued. This land is marked by flags on the west side of the church property. As developments warrant, additional information will be shared with the congregation. A congregational vote would be needed to sell the property. At this time, the identities of any potential buyers will remain anonymous.
