## **COUNCIL REPORT NOVEMBER 2022:**

**New Missionary** – The Missions Team is pleased to announce a new missionary partner, Jodi Oppenhuizen. Jodi serves at the Christian International School of Prague in the Czech Republic. Jodi will be introduced via video in the November 13 service as well as a newsletter sent with the bulletin.

**Pulpit Supply Update** – On November 20, Pastor Scott Muilenburg will lead worship and administer baptism. Pastor Muilenburg is a brother of Stacia Veenstra and is pastor at First CRC in Edgerton, MN. Beginning in January 2023, Mr. Scott Roose is planning to join us for a ten-part sermon series. Mr. Roose led worship here this past spring and is the Bible teacher at Pella Christian High School.

**Membership Transfers** – Council approved outgoing membership transfers for three families. Corey and Katie Magnussen and family are transferring to Shady Grove Wesleyan Church in Colfax, NC.
