

#### AUGUST 2023 COUNCIL REPORT:

- 1. The council interview with Pastor Ty was discussed.
- Welcome New Members The memberships of Dan and Lisa Zylstra with their children Emily, Caroline, Paul and Joseph from Bethel CRC in DeMotte, Indiana, and of Loren and Carla Dykstra from Prairie City CRC were accepted with thanksgiving and approved by council. We pray for God's blessings on these families.
- 3. Robert Rus will attend Classis Central Plains, representing Cornerstone Church, on September 15-16. This will be held at Trinity CRC in St. Louis, MO.
- 4. Our Missions Team has asked that Joel and Jeannie Huyser be added to our missionary support list. Council voted to approve.
- 5. The upcoming visit by Pastor Paul Hoekstra was discussed, and preparations to the parsonage have been made for his arrival. He is scheduled to be with us as interim pastor from September 13-December 10.

**BACKPACK PROGRAM**: 10% of lowans are considered food insecure (do not know where their next meal is coming from) and 1/3 of those lowans are children. For 14 years the Pella BackPack Program has provided kid friendly, nutritious sacks of food for children in Pella Schools every Friday during the school year. This year the program will provide backpack buddies to around 50 students between Pella Community Schools & Pella Christian Grade School. Last year Cornerstone donated well over 200 single entree (mac & cheese, ravioli etc.) items for the backpack program and we've been asked to help again! There is a table in the fellowship hall where donated items can be placed and you'll find a few examples of the type of single entree items they'll accept. Let's hit our goal of 200 items again as we continue to support this very necessary program!
