

RESULTS OF THE CONGFREGATIONAL VOTE FROM MARCH 17:

- 1. Twelve absentee ballots were gathered. 97 members were in attendance. Total votes were 109.
- 2. A 66.67% threshold need to be presented for a vote to pass. This comes to 73 votes needed.
- 3. 98 "yes" votes were given. 11 "no" votes were given.
- 4. A "yes" vote passed by 89.9%. Cornerstone Church of Pella, IA has chosen to extend a pastoral call to Ryan Landt of Calvary CRC in Lowell, MI.
- 5. Will Van Wyngarden and Joe Van Haaften, representing the Council and the Pastor Search Team, will reach out to Pastor Ryan and inform him of our decision.
- 6. The Council has approved and signed the Letter of Call.
- 7. We await Pastor Ryan's decision on whether he will accept the call.
